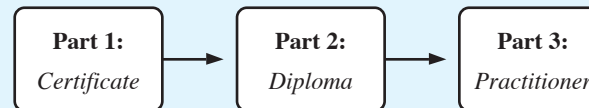
Diploma students and graduates are eligible for membership with the British Society of Clinical Hypnosis (BSCH) and the British Association of Medical Hypnosis.

Course Structure



Part 1: Certificate in Clinical Hypnosis

The aim of this four months intensive course is to provide a thorough introduction to hypnosis, enabling those attending to obtain a foundation of knowledge for both personal and professional development. Ten induction methods, depth of trance, management of hypnotic state, contra-indications and the use of suggestions along with safe ethical practice form the basis. The course is part-time, presented on four intermittent weekends. Students are required to do reading, written work and an examination as part of the course structure.

Part 2: Diploma in Clinical Hypnosis (Hons)

The Diploma Course requires students to attend on twelve intermittent weekends. Students will be taught an extensive tool box of techniques, induction and methodologies which are combined with the extensive application to medical, psychological and behavioural conditions.

Part 3: Practitioners Diploma in Clinical Hypnosis

The aim of the Practitioner Course is to equip the qualified Practitioner with the latest hypnotherapeutic techniques for dealing with a wider range of medical, psychological and somatic problems. The course also includes treatment of sexual abuse and trauma and is an excellent adjunct for counselors.
